

## The Michigan QSO Party:



Saturday April 15, is the Michigan QSO Party, running from Noon to Midnight.

MIQP is one of many State QSO Party events. It is a somewhat leisurely-paced “contest,” the object of which is for out-of state hams to work as many MI stations as possible and for MI stations to stack up QSOs with everyone else. A QSO exchange sent is RS(T)+MI County (“WAYN” in our case), and other state sends RS(T)+their State abbreviation.

LARC will operate with the club’s gear and callsign, N8LPD, from the City of Livonia Emergency Operations Center (EOC).

Winners (clubs and individuals) receive certificates or Plaques (and entitlement to bragging rights) from the contest’s long time sponsor, the Mad River Radio Club.

Fun fact: LARC has finished First Place in the EOC category many times, including 2022.

LARC Members are permitted entry to the EOC, and, as a licensed ham, can operate the club station for this event. This is a great opportunity for newcomers to get a taste of Contesting (a.k.a. “radiosport) in a low-stress environment. Unlike some other fast-paced, high-volume, high-speed events, like the world-wide SSB, CW or digital DX contests, this one is slower paced, and we’re in it mostly for the fun of it.

Tech licensees will have a chance to sample HF band operating; Generals might get to foray into the Extra Class sub-bands. We’ll be doing CW, too!

We’d enjoy having you come by and take part with your club in this event, even for a short visit.

Please let us know if/when you would like to operate or assist by filling out a signup form at the LARC website. The form is to let the club know when you can do Saturday operating time or to help with Friday afternoon 12-2p antenna raising, but can also give us a heads up that you might be coming.



## Livonia Police Department | Emergency Operations Center:

The Livonia PD building is at 14050 Farmington Road, just south of Five Mile. Access the front entrance parking lot from Civic Center Drive. You must check in as a radio club member with the desk officer, who is provided with a copy of our 2023 membership roster. Our relationship with LPD allows only valid LARC members entry to the building. Once OK'd you will be buzzed through the stairway door. The EOC is adjacent to the Training Room, on the basement level.

Face masks are optional, but feel free to bring and wear one if you feel more comfortable doing so among other people.
